April 2019

- *Edgewater Resources Group* has forwarded a preliminary proposal for the electrical updates (ESD) that include:

 - *Bid documents*
 - *Construction administration*

May 2019

- *Edgewater Resource Group*
 - Met with Colin Hassinger to discuss options to the ESD Project along with how to move forward on the re-decking project.
 - A written summary will be submitted week of May 15th which will then be reviewed with the committee.
 - Discussed the ESD project as it pertains to re-decking. Would be phased in to switch out power box as each dock is completed.

- Reviewing cost analysis prior to proceeding on upgrades of the docks.

July 2019

- *Edgewater Resources* had submitted a quote in relation to the ESP.

September 2019

- 800 Dock ESD specs to be finalized by week of Sept. 16th
- Expecting a visit from the manufacturer of the MEE outlet box that will be used.

October 2019

- Mr. Hassenger from *Edgewater Resource Group* explained that the project is almost ready to go out for bid. They have planned out what are feasible and practical improvements to the electrical system; a representative from the leading manufacturer was here to evaluate what is required along the dock.

November 2019

- Mr. Hassenger of *Edgewater Resources* has completed bids for the 800 dock electrical work which will be distributed the week of November 18th.

December 2019

- Mr. Hassenger of *Edgewater Resources* had previously completed bids for the 800 dock electrical work which were distributed; all bids received will be opened during the December 16th meeting.
